## Congolese primary pupil Tony Lola wins deportation battle

Home Office lifts threat to deport the nine-year-old Didsbury student and his political activist mother to Congo after his school organised a campaign to keep him in the UK. The campaigners at Didsbury primary school were ... (1) ... about the fate of Tony Lola, a year 5 pupil, who is a failed asylum seeker.

The Home Office's original decision to deport him and his mother had horrified his schoolfriends and staff.
