Congolese primary pupil Tony Lola wins deportation battle

Home Office lifts threat to deport the nine-year-old Didsbury student and his political activist mother to Congo after his school organised a campaign to keep him in the UK. The campaigners at Didsbury primary school were ... (1) ... about the fate of Tony Lola, a year 5 pupil, who is a failed asylum seeker.

The Home Office's original decision to deport him and his mother had horrified his schoolfriends and staff. But today it emerged that the immigration minister has granted Tony and his mother, Mireille Maswa, leave to remain in the UK. The school organised a petition that collected thousands of ... (2) ... and the children urged the home secretary to reverse the decision to deport Tony.
